Psy Fi: Literature and Psychoanalysis

Description: Origins and major concepts of psychoanalysis explored through a close analysis of Freud's writings with a particular focus on their literary dimension. The course seeks not simply to apply Freud to literature but also to see how psychoanalytic thinking itself might be enriched and expanded by our approaching it through works of art, literature and cinema. Thus, in addition to readings of Freud's writings on dreams, infantile sexuality, trauma, and the unconscious, we will study films by Hitchcock, a wide range of literary texts from German, French, Anglo-American and Latin American traditions, and critical essays by Deleuze, Zizek, Bronfen, Felman, Weber, Ronell and others.
